AN ACT CONCERNING STATE AGENCY AFFIRMATIVE ACTION PLANS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 46a-68 of the general statutes is amended by
2 adding subsection (h) as follows:

3 (NEW) (h) The Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities
4 may exempt a state agency, department, board or commission that
5 employs twenty or less full-time employees from the requirements of
6 subsections (a), (b) and (c) of this section.

7 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from its passage.

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt a state agency, department, board or commission with twenty or less full-time employees from the requirements to develop, file and implement an affirmative action plan, since the personnel activity of an agency of this size is limited and the agency would only report insignificant results.
