***AN ACT CONCERNING APPEALS TO THE WORKERS'  
COMPENSATION COMMISSION BOARD.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Subsection (a) of section 31-301 of the general statutes is repealed  
2 and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 (a) At any time within [ten] twenty days after entry of an award by  
4 the commissioner, after a decision of the commissioner upon a motion  
5 or after an order by the commissioner according to the provisions of  
6 section 31-299b, either party may appeal therefrom to the  
7 Compensation Review Board by filing in the office of the  
8 commissioner from which the award or the decision on a motion  
9 originated an appeal petition and five copies thereof. The  
10 commissioner within three days thereafter shall mail the petition and  
11 three copies thereof to the chief of the Compensation Review Board  
12 and a copy thereof to the adverse party or parties.

***Statement of Purpose:***

To increase the number of days from ten to twenty in which a party may file a petition for review to the Compensation Review Board pursuant to a decision of the Appellate Court.
