AN ACT CONCERNING RURAL AGRICULTURAL LAND USES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) No zoning regulation adopted pursuant to chapter 124 of the
2 general statutes or any special act shall prohibit the keeping of
3 domestic animals for supervised youth agricultural experiences
4 sponsored by an organization that is exempt from taxation under
5 Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any
6 subsequent corresponding internal revenue code of the United States,
7 as from time to time amended, in any area which is zoned for
8 residential use on lots of one or more acres.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit the exclusion of the keeping of livestock and small pets for supervised youth agricultural experiences in residential areas.
