Substitute Bill No. 1126

AN ACT CONCERNING RURAL AGRICULTURAL LAND USES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 (NEW) No zoning regulation adopted pursuant to chapter 124 of the
2 general statutes or any special act shall prohibit the keeping of
3 domestic animals for supervised youth agricultural projects sponsored
4 by an organization that is exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3)
5 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or any subsequent
6 corresponding internal revenue code of the United States, as from time
7 to time amended, in any area which is zoned for residential use on lots
8 of one or more acres. Nothing in this section shall prohibit a zoning
9 board from establishing a limit on the number of domestic animals
10 kept for such projects sponsored by an such an organization.
