AN ACT CONCERNING OUT-OF-STATE SHIPPER'S PERMITS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 30-18 of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

3 An out-of-state shipper's permit for alcoholic liquor other than beer
4 shall allow the sale of such alcoholic liquor to manufacturer and
5 wholesaler permittees in this state as permitted by law. The permit
6 premises of an out-of-state shipper's permit for alcoholic liquor may be
7 located within this state or outside this state. The annual fee for an out-
8 of-state shipper's permit for alcoholic liquor other than beer shall be
9 forty-five dollars for a Connecticut manufacturer or wholesaler
10 holding such a permit and shall be one thousand dollars for any other
11 person holding such a permit.

12 Sec. 2. Section 30-19 of the general statutes is repealed and the
13 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

14 An out-of-state shipper's permit for beer shall allow the sale of beer
15 to manufacturer and wholesaler permittees in this state as permitted

16 by law. The permit premises of an out-of-state shipper's permit for
17 beer may be located within this state or outside this state. The annual
18 fee for an out-of-state shipper's permit for beer shall be forty-five
19 dollars for a Connecticut manufacturer or wholesaler holding such a
20 permit and shall be one thousand dollars for any other person holding
21 such a permit.
