***AN ACT ESTABLISHING PROGRAMMATIC CONNECTIONS  
BETWEEN THE STATE'S INDUSTRY CLUSTER AND WORKFORCE  
DEVELOPMENT INITIATIVES AND PROGRAMS OFFERED BY  
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS.***

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General  
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) On or before January 1, 2002, and annually  
2 thereafter, the Connecticut Employment and Training Commission  
3 shall report to the select committee of the General Assembly having  
4 cognizance of matters relating to workforce development concerning  
5 any initiatives undertaken by the commission to establish  
6 programmatic connections between the state's industry cluster and  
7 workforce development initiatives and educational programs at  
8 regional community-technical colleges and other educational  
9 institutions, including secondary and postsecondary institutions and  
10 regional vocational-technical schools.

11 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect from its passage.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To establish programmatic connections between the state's industry cluster and workforce development initiatives and programs offered by educational institutions.
