AN ACT CONCERNING THE FILING OF LIMITED LIABILITY DOCUMENTS WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) The Secretary of the State may adopt regulations,
2 in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes,
3 governing the filing with and delivery of documents to the office of the
4 Secretary of the State under sections 34-100 to 34-242, inclusive, of the
5 general statutes, as amended by this act, by electronic means,
6 including facsimile and computer transmission.

7 Sec. 2. Section 34-110 of the general statutes is repealed and the
8 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

9 (a) The original signed copy of the articles of organization or any
10 other document required to be filed pursuant to sections 34-100 to 34-
11 242, inclusive, shall be delivered to the Secretary of the State. The
12 articles of organization or any other document required to be filed
13 shall be typewritten or printed or, if authorized by the Secretary of the
14 State, electronically transmitted. Unless the Secretary of the State
15 determines that the document does not conform to the filing

16 provisions of said sections, [he] the Secretary of the State shall, when
17 all required filing fees have been paid: (1) Endorse on each signed
18 original of the document "filed" and the date and time of its acceptance
19 for filing; and (2) retain the signed original in [his] the Secretary of the
20 State's files.

21 (b) If the Secretary of the State determines that the document does
22 not conform to the filing provisions of sections 34-100 to 34-242,
23 inclusive, or is not accompanied by all fees required by law, the
24 document shall not be filed and the Secretary of the State shall return
25 the document to the person originally submitting it.

Statement of Purpose:

To authorize the Secretary of the State to adopt regulations to permit limited liability company documents to be filed electronically with the office of the Secretary of the State.
