**AN ACT CONCERNING COLLEGE CREDIT FOR COURSEWORK AT
THE CONNECTICUT POLICE ACADEMY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) The Board of Trustees for the Community-Technical
- 2 Colleges shall establish procedures for the awarding of appropriate
- 3 college credit toward the completion of an associate degree for any
- 4 student attending the Connecticut Police Academy who is enrolled in a
- 5 law enforcement program at said academy.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow students attending the Connecticut Police Academy to earn
college credit toward the completion of an associate degree for law
enforcement coursework undertaken at the academy.
