**AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A
CAREER LADDER FOR POLICE OFFICER, FIREFIGHTER AND EMT
EXPLORERS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Not later than one year after the effective date of this section, the
2 Commissioner of Public Safety shall submit a report to the joint
3 standing committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of
4 matters relating to public safety and appropriations and to the select
5 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
6 relating to workforce development concerning whether the state shall
7 establish and fund a career ladder to enable a person participating in a
8 police officer, firefighter or emergency medical technician explorers
9 program operated by an organized local police or fire department, or a
10 volunteer fire company or emergency medical services organization to
11 receive credit towards (1) certification as a police officer, firefighter or
12 emergency medical technician, or (2) the completion of an associate
13 degree in law enforcement, criminal justice or emergency medical or
14 fire services at a regional community-technical college.
