**AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR PROGRAMS OF THE
DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 (NEW) The Commissioner of Agriculture shall review the programs
- 2 administered by the Department of Agriculture in order to: (1)
- 3 Evaluate the cost-effectiveness and benefits of such programs; and (2)
- 4 assign priority for the continued funding of such programs. The
- 5 commissioner shall submit findings and recommendations to the joint
- 6 standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of
- 7 matters relating to appropriations and the budgets of state agencies not
- 8 later than February 20, 2002, and annually thereafter.

To review expenditures for programs within the Department of
Agriculture.
