"AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE USE OF TRANSACTION SCAN DEVICES BY SELLERS OF ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR AND TOBACCO."

1 After line 195, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 3. Subsection (a) of section 30-77 of the general statutes is
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 (a) Any person who, without a permit therefor, except as provided
5 in section 30-37 or subsection (b) of section 12-436, the provisions of
6 which shall not be construed as requiring an individual to be
7 physically present at the point of purchase of alcoholic beverages to
8 import such alcoholic beverages, or contrary to the provisions of this
9 chapter and the regulations of the Department of Consumer Protection
10 with respect to the class of permit held by [him] such person,
11 manufactures or, by sample, by soliciting or procuring orders, or
12 otherwise, sells or delivers, or offers or exposes for sale or delivery, or

13 owns or keeps with intent to sell or deliver, or who ships, transports or
14 imports into this state, any alcoholic liquor, shall be subject to the
15 penalties prescribed in section 30-113; provided nothing in this section
16 shall prohibit any common carrier, warehouseman or other lien holder,
17 or any officer acting under legal process, or any insurance company
18 that acquires the same as the result of fire, flood or water damage,
19 from exercising [his or its] the right of such person or such entity to sell
20 alcoholic liquor under a lien or such process or such acquisition, with
21 the permission of the department. The provisions of this section shall
22 not apply to the delivery to a permittee under this chapter of alcoholic
23 liquor which is legally authorized. The provisions of this section shall
24 not apply to the shipment into this state of ethyl alcohol intended for
25 use or used for scientific, mechanical and industrial uses, for use in
26 hospitals and public institutions, for medicinal purposes in the
27 manufacture of patented, proprietary, medicinal, pharmaceutical,
28 antiseptic, toilet, scientific, chemical, mechanical and industrial
29 preparations or products not sold as a beverage for human
30 consumption, nor to the shipment of wine to be used in the
31 manufacture of patented, proprietary or pharmaceutical preparations
32 or products or in the manufacture of fruit preserves. No such shipment
33 shall be made except with the approval of the department and only in
34 such manner as the department prescribes. The department shall
35 notify the Commissioner of Revenue Services of the approval of any
36 such shipment."
