"AN ACT CONCERNING NOISE REGULATION OF THE UCONN STADIUM AT RENTSCHLER FIELD IN EAST HARTFORD."

1 Strike out lines 1 to 23, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 32-664 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (b) Each license, permit and approval required or permitted to be
6 issued and each administrative action required or permitted to be
7 taken pursuant to the general statutes in connection with the overall
8 project shall be issued or taken upon application to the particular
9 commissioner or commissioners having the jurisdiction over such
10 license, permit, approval or other administrative action or such other
11 state official as such commissioner shall designate. No agency,
12 commission, council, committee, panel or other body whatsoever other
13 than such commissioner shall have jurisdiction over or cognizance of

14 any licenses, permits, approvals or administrative actions concerning
15 the overall project. No notice of any tentative determination or any
16 final determination regarding any such license, permit, approval or
17 administrative action and no notice of any such license, permit,
18 approval or administrative action shall be required except as expressly
19 provided in this section. No ordinance, law or regulation adopted by,
20 or authority granted to, any municipality or any other political
21 subdivision of the state shall apply to the overall project, except that
22 the stadium facility and the stadium facility project shall comply with
23 the provisions of any local noise ordinance that embraces the ambient
24 noise standard, as provided in section 22a-69, except that such local
25 noise ordinance shall not apply to The University of Connecticut
26 sporting events. Any enforcement action shall be based on objective
27 scientific measurements.

28 Sec. 2. Subsection (b) of section 32-665 of the general statutes is
29 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

30 (b) The operation of the convention center, the stadium facility and
31 the related parking facilities shall be subject to applicable ordinances,
32 laws or regulations relating to state facilities, provided the operation of
33 the convention center, stadium facility and the related parking
34 facilities shall not be subject to the following provisions of the general
35 statutes, including any regulations adopted thereunder: Sections 4a-1
36 to 4a-59a, inclusive, title 4b, chapter 97a, and sections 10-303 and 14-
37 311 to 14-314c, inclusive. [For the purposes of subsection (g) of section
38 22a-68, the activities at the stadium facility shall be deemed sanctioned
39 by the state.]"
