"AN ACT CONCERNING REGISTRATION STICKERS ON MOTOR VEHICLES."

1 After line 41, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 2. Section 14-254 of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 "Disabled veteran", as used in this section, means any veteran who
6 served in time of war, as defined by section 27-103, and one or both of
7 whose legs or arms or parts thereof have been amputated or the use of
8 which has been lost or who is blind, or who have traumatic brain
9 injury, or paraplegic or hemiplegic, such disability being certified as
10 service-connected by the Veterans' Administration. The Commissioner
11 of Motor Vehicles, upon application of any disabled veteran
12 accompanied by such certificate of the Veterans' Administration, shall
13 issue without charge a special number plate or set of plates in
14 accordance with the provisions of subsection (a) of section 14-21b to be
15 attached to a passenger motor vehicle owned or operated by such

16 veteran and an identification card to be used in connection therewith.
17 The card shall identify the veteran and the motor vehicle and shall
18 state that [he] such veteran is a disabled veteran qualified to receive
19 the card, that the card, plate or plates shall be returned to the
20 commissioner if the registration of the motor vehicle is cancelled or
21 transferred, that the card is for the exclusive use of the person to whom
22 it is issued, is not transferable and will be revoked if presented by any
23 other person or if any privilege granted under this section is abused. If
24 not so revoked, the card shall be renewable every four years at the
25 time of registration of motor vehicles. No penalty shall be imposed for
26 the overtime parking of any motor vehicle bearing a number plate
27 issued under this section when it has been so parked by the disabled
28 veteran to whom the plate and an identification card were issued or by
29 any person operating such vehicle when accompanied by such veteran,
30 provided the length of time for which such vehicle may remain parked
31 at any one location shall not exceed twenty-four hours. The surviving
32 spouse of a disabled veteran issued such special registration may
33 retain any such registration and number plates without charge for his
34 or her lifetime or until such time as he or she remarries."
