**"AN ACT CONCERNING VITAL RECORDS."**

1      Strike out lines 490 to 502, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the  
2      following in lieu thereof:

3      "(c) For death certificates, the Social Security number of the  
4      deceased person shall be recorded on the face of the certificate. The  
5      occupation, business or industry, race, Hispanic origin, if applicable,  
6      and educational level of the deceased person, if known, shall be  
7      recorded in the "administrative purposes" section of the death  
8      certificate. All parties specified on the certificate, including the  
9      informant, licensed funeral director, licensed embalmer, conservator,  
10     surviving spouse, physician and town clerk or registrar, or other  
11     persons, as authorized by the commissioner, shall have access to the  
12     Social Security number of the deceased person and the information  
13     recorded in the "administrative purposes" section of the death  
14     certificate. Any other individual requesting a certified or uncertified  
15     copy of any death certificate in accordance with the provisions of this

16 section, for a death occurring after July 1, 1997, shall be provided such  
17 copy, if more than sixty days have passed since the date of death, with  
18 the Social Security number of the deceased person included, except  
19 that the "administrative purposes" section shall be omitted."

20 After line 1208, insert the following and renumber the remaining  
21 section accordingly:

22 "Sec. 36. Subsection (d) of section 17b-137a of the general statutes is  
23 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

24 (d) Any Social Security number of any individual on any record or  
25 document required pursuant to this section shall not be disclosed  
26 except as provided under section 17b-137 or subsection (c) of section 7-  
27 51a, as amended by this act."
