"AN ACT CONCERNING DIRECT PRIMARIES."

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- 1 In line 41, strike "and" and insert a comma in lieu thereof
 - 2 In line 41, after "birth", insert "and the printing of the names"
 - 3 In line 47, after "different", insert "state"
 - 4 Strike line 105 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:
5 "indicated by placing a mark in a manner prescribed by the Secretary
6 before the name rejected. The registrar may"
 - 7 In line 112, before ", and", insert "in the municipality of the registrar"
 - 8 In line 119, after "shall", insert "immediately"
 - 9 In line 158, after "certificate", insert "or petition"

10 In line 168, after the period, insert the following: "A petition filed by
11 or on behalf of a candidate for state office shall be invalid for such
12 candidate if such candidate is certified as the party-endorsed candidate
13 pursuant to section 9-388 or as receiving at least fifteen per cent of the
14 convention vote for such office pursuant to this subsection."

15 In line 169, after "period" and before the comma, insert "and the
16 completion of the tabulation of petition signatures, if any"

17 In line 209, after the period, insert the following: "A petition may
18 only be filed by or on behalf of a candidate for the district office of
19 state senator, state representative or judge of probate who is not
20 certified as the party-endorsed candidate pursuant to section 9-388 or
21 as receiving at least fifteen per cent of the convention vote for such
22 office pursuant to this subsection. A petition filed by or on behalf of a
23 candidate for the district office of representative in Congress shall be
24 invalid if said candidate is certified as the party-endorsed candidate
25 pursuant to section 9-388 or as receiving at least fifteen per cent of the
26 convention vote for such office pursuant to this subsection."

28 completion of the tabulation of petition signatures, if any"

29 Strike sections 6 and 7 in their entirety and renumber the remaining
30 sections accordingly

31 In line 280, strike the comma after "receipt" and strike "in duplicate,"

32 Strike line 294 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:
33 "[the] placing [of an "R"] a mark in a manner prescribed by the
34 Secretary before the name so rejected. The registrar"

35 In line 349, after "district" and before the comma, insert the
36 following: "and each part of a municipality which is a component part
37 of the district"

41 "(e) If candidacies for election as delegates to a convention of a
42 political party are filed by or on behalf of a slate of persons other than
43 party-endorsed candidates within the time specified in section 9-405
44 and in conformity with the provisions of sections 9-405, 9-406a to 9-
45 410, inclusive, and 9-412, as amended by this act, a primary shall be
46 held in the municipality or political subdivision of the municipality in
47 which delegates to a convention are to be elected, or in each
48 municipality in the district in which district delegates to a convention
49 are to be elected, as the case may be, for the purpose of electing the
50 delegates to the convention, except as provided in section 9-420."
