"AN ACT CONCERNING DIRECT PRIMARIES."

1 Strike section 4 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Sec. 4. Section 9-383 of the general statutes is repealed and the
3 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 The time and place of meeting of a state or district convention shall
5 be fixed by the state central committee or other authority of the party
6 holding such convention, in accordance with the rules of such party;
7 provided each such convention held to endorse candidates for state or
8 district office to be voted upon at a state election shall be convened not
9 earlier than the [sixty-eighth] sixty-fourth day and closed not later than
10 the fiftieth day preceding the day of the primary for such office."

11 After line 454, insert the following and renumber the remaining
12 section accordingly:

13 "Sec. 12. Section 9-423 of the general statutes is repealed and the

14 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

15 The primaries of all parties for nomination to an office to be voted
16 on at a regular state election shall be held on the one hundred fifth day
17 preceding the day of said election. The primaries of all parties for
18 nomination to an office to be voted on at a regular municipal election
19 shall be held on the fifty-sixth day preceding the day of the election.

20 Sec. 13. Section 9-424 of the general statutes is repealed and the
21 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

22 The day for holding primaries for the purpose of electing delegates
23 to state and district conventions held to endorse candidates for office
24 shall be the [third Tuesday] first Tuesday after the second Monday in
25 May. The day for holding primaries for the purpose of electing
26 delegates to a state or district convention held for any other purpose
27 shall be the first Tuesday occurring on or after the fifty-eighth day
28 prior to the convention."
