**"AN ACT ADDING REAL ESTATE BROKERS TO THE LIST OF
PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CORPORATIONS AND
PROFESSIONAL SERVICE LIMITED LIABILITY COMPANIES."**

1 Strike out everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Subdivision (1) of section 33-182a of the general statutes
4 is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (1) "Professional service" means any type of service to the public
6 that requires that members of a profession rendering such service
7 obtain a license or other legal authorization as a condition precedent to
8 the rendition thereof, limited to the professional services rendered by
9 dentists, natureopaths, chiropractors, physicians and surgeons, doctors
10 of dentistry, physical therapists, occupational therapists, podiatrists,
11 optometrists, nurses, nurse-midwives, veterinarians, pharmacists,
12 architects, professional engineers, or jointly by architects and

13 professional engineers, landscape architects, real estate brokers,
14 insurance producers, certified public accountants and public
15 accountants, land surveyors, psychologists, attorneys-at-law, licensed
16 marital and family therapists, licensed professional counselors and
17 licensed clinical social workers.

18 Sec. 2. Subdivision (17) of section 34-101 of the general statutes is
19 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

20 (17) "Professional service" means any type of service to the public
21 that requires that members of a profession rendering such service
22 obtain a license or other legal authorization as a condition precedent to
23 the rendition thereof, limited to the professional services rendered by
24 dentists, natureopaths, chiropractors, physicians and surgeons, doctors
25 of dentistry, physical therapists, occupational therapists, podiatrists,
26 optometrists, nurses, nurse-midwives, veterinarians, pharmacists,
27 architects, professional engineers, or jointly by architects and
28 professional engineers, landscape architects, real estate brokers,
