"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PERMITTING OF POUND NETS."

1 In line 104, after "structure" insert "that was not utilized prior to the
2 effective date of this act"

3 After line 110, insert the following and renumber the remaining
4 section accordingly:

5 "Sec. 2. Section 22-455 of the general statutes is repealed and the
6 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

7 There is established a Connecticut Seafood Advisory Council to
8 assist in the promotion of Connecticut seafood products and examine
9 market opportunities. The advisory council shall consist of one
10 freshwater fish producer appointed by the Governor, two finfish,
11 shellfish or lobster harvesters or representatives of harvester
12 organizations appointed one each by the speaker and majority leader
13 of the House of Representatives, two finfish, shellfish or lobster
14 processors or representatives of processor organizations appointed one
15 each by the minority leaders of the Senate and House of

16 Representatives, one retailer serving restaurants or representing a
17 restaurant organization appointed by the president pro tempore of the
18 Senate, one member at-large appointed by the majority leader of the
19 Senate, and four nonvoting members one of whom shall represent the
20 Department of Environmental Protection, one the Department of
21 Economic and Community Development and one the Department of
22 Agriculture and one the Sea Grant Program at The University of
23 Connecticut. The advisory council shall be within the Department of
24 Agriculture.

25 Sec. 3. (NEW) The Connecticut Seafood Advisory Council may
26 utilize federal, state or other available funds, and may enter into
27 contracts in order to carry out the purposes of this section."
