1 After line 80, insert the following and renumber the remaining  
2 section accordingly:

3 "Sec. 3. Section 1-217 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (a) No public agency may disclose, under the Freedom of  
6 Information Act, the residential address of any of the following  
7 persons:

8 (1) A federal court judge, federal court magistrate, judge of the  
9 Superior Court, Appellate Court or Supreme Court of the state, or  
10 family support magistrate;

11 (2) A sworn member of a municipal police department or a sworn  
12 member of the Division of State Police within the Department of Public  
13 Safety;

14 (3) An employee of the Department of Correction;

- 15 (4) An attorney-at-law who represents or has represented the state  
16 in a criminal prosecution;
- 17 (5) An attorney-at-law who is or has been employed by the Public  
18 Defender Services Division or a social worker who is employed by the  
19 Public Defender Services Division;
- 20 (6) An inspector employed by the Division of Criminal Justice;
- 21 (7) A firefighter;
- 22 (8) An employee of the Department of Children and Families; [or]
- 23 (9) A member or employee of the Board of Parole; or
- 24 (10) An employee of the Judicial Branch.
- 25 (b) The business address of any person described in this section  
26 shall be subject to disclosure under section 1-210. The provisions of this  
27 section shall not apply to Department of Motor Vehicles records  
28 described in section 14-10."
