**"AN ACT CONCERNING MINOR CHANGES TO THE INSURANCE STATUTES."**

1 After line 131, add the following:

2 "Sec. 7. Subdivision (10) of section 38a-567 of the general statutes is  
3 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 (10) Each insurer participating in the small employer market shall  
5 actively market all of its plans, except association group plans, to all  
6 small employers regardless of the number of eligible employees. If a  
7 small employer carrier denies coverage to a small employer, the small  
8 employer carrier shall promptly offer the small employer the  
9 opportunity to purchase a special health care plan or a small employer  
10 health care plan, as appropriate. If a small employer carrier or any  
11 producer representing that carrier fails, for any reason, to offer such  
12 coverage as requested by a small employer, that small employer carrier  
13 shall promptly offer the small employer an opportunity to purchase a  
14 special health care plan or a small employer health care plan, as  
15 appropriate."
