9 later than thirty days before trial, ₂ file with the clerk of the court a
10 written notice signed by [him or his] the defendant or the defendant's
11 attorney, directed to the plaintiff or [his] the plaintiff's attorney,
12 offering to allow the plaintiff to take judgment for the sum named in
13 such notice."
