**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADVISORY BOARD OF THE  
SECOND INJURY FUND."**

1 Strike out everything after the enacting clause and substitute the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 31-349e of the general statutes is repealed and the following  
4 is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 There shall be an advisory board for the Second Injury Fund to  
6 advise the custodian of the Second Injury Fund on matters concerning  
7 administration, operation, claim handling and finances of the fund. On  
8 or before July 1, 1995, the Treasurer shall appoint six of the eight  
9 members to the board. Three members shall represent employers and  
10 insurers who pay assessments to the fund pursuant to section 31-354.  
11 Three such members shall represent employees receiving benefits paid  
12 or reimbursed by the fund. The two remaining members shall be the  
13 [chairmen] chairpersons of the labor and public employees committee  
14 of the General Assembly or their designees. The six members  
15 appointed by the Treasurer shall be appointed for a term of four years

16 from January first in the year of their appointment. Any vacancy shall  
17 be filled for the remainder of the term in the same manner as the  
18 original appointment. All members shall serve without compensation.  
19 The board shall elect a [chairman] chairperson from among its  
20 members. The Treasurer shall provide such staff as is necessary for the  
21 performance of the functions and duties of the board. The board shall  
22 meet at least twice a year. All actions of the board shall require an  
23 affirmative vote of [six members, or their designees, of the board] a  
24 majority of those members present and voting, provided at least four  
25 members shall be present and voting. The board may adopt any rules  
26 of procedure that it deems necessary to carry out its duties."
