**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEATH PENALTY."**

1       After line 139, add the following and renumber the remaining  
2       section accordingly:

3       "Sec. 5. (NEW) Notwithstanding any provision of the general  
4       statutes, from the effective date of this act until July 1, 2003, the  
5       execution of the sentence of death with respect to any person who has  
6       been convicted of a capital felony and sentenced to death before, on or  
7       after the effective date of this act shall be stayed and the death penalty  
8       shall not be inflicted upon such person."
