12 shall submit to the commissioner for review and approval a plan that
13 describes the extent and degree of the nuisance or damage and the

14 proposed methods of take or other lethal and non-lethal options
15 proposed, considered or implemented. A homeowner association shall
16 obtain authorization from the decision making body of the
17 municipality in which it is located to implement the plan approved by
18 the commissioner."

33 time or place if a severe nuisance or ecological damage can be
34 demonstrated to the satisfaction of the commissioner provided the
35 municipality or homeowner association decision making body has first
36 voted to request such authority. A municipality or a homeowner
37 association shall submit to the commissioner for review and approval a
38 plan that describes the extent and degree of the nuisance or damage
39 and the proposed methods of take or other lethal and non-lethal
40 options proposed, considered or implemented. A homeowner
41 association shall obtain authorization from the decision making body

42 of the municipality in which it is located to implement the plan
43 approved by the commissioner."
