**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF A STATE
CHILDREN'S POLICY."**

1 Strike section 1 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu thereof:

2 "Section 1. (NEW) (a) The Department of Social Services shall make
3 informational materials available in an electronic format on its website
4 concerning the availability of health insurance for certain eligible
5 children under the HUSKY plan pursuant to chapter 319v of the
6 general statutes. The materials shall contain information, including,
7 but not limited to, a toll free number and an address for obtaining
8 more information on the HUSKY plan.

9 (b) Each employer shall post, in a conspicuous manner in the place
10 of employment, the HUSKY plan notice described in subsection (a) of
11 this section. Each employer may provide such information to
12 prospective employees at the time of hire. For purposes of this section,

13 "employer" has the meaning ascribed to it in section 38a-531 of the
14 general statutes."
