**"AN ACT CONCERNING VIDEO GAMES."**

- 1 In line 1, before "(NEW)" insert "Section 1."  
2 After line 23, insert the following:  
3 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 13a-123 of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:  
5 (a) The erection of outdoor advertising structures, signs, displays or  
6 devices within six hundred sixty feet of the edge of the right-of-way,  
7 the advertising message of which is visible from the main traveled way  
8 of any portion of the National System of Interstate and Defense  
9 Highways, hereinafter referred to as interstate highways, the primary  
10 system of federal-aid highways or other limited access state highways,  
11 is prohibited except as otherwise provided in or pursuant to this  
12 section, and except that (1) those outdoor advertising signs, displays

13 and devices which are more than six hundred sixty feet off the nearest  
14 edge of the right-of-way, located outside of urban areas, visible from  
15 the main traveled way of the system and erected with the purpose of  
16 their message being read from such main traveled way are prohibited,  
17 and (2) those outdoor advertising signs, displays and devices which  
18 contain any obscene language or image and are visible from the main  
19 traveled way of the system and erected with the purpose of their  
20 message being read from such main traveled way are prohibited."
