**"AN ACT CONCERNING DIRECT PRIMARIES."**

1      In line 168, after the period, insert the following: "A petition filed by  
2      or on behalf of a candidate for state office shall be invalid for such  
3      candidate if such candidate is certified as the party-endorsed candidate  
4      pursuant to section 9-388 or as receiving at least fifteen per cent of the  
5      convention vote for such office pursuant to this subsection."

6      In line 209, after the period, insert the following: "A petition may  
7      only be filed by or on behalf of a candidate for the district office of  
8      state senator, state representative or judge of probate who is not  
9      certified as the party-endorsed candidate pursuant to section 9-388 or  
10     as receiving at least fifteen per cent of the convention vote for such  
11     office pursuant to this subsection. A petition filed by or on behalf of a  
12     candidate for the district office of representative in Congress shall be  
13     invalid if said candidate is certified as the party-endorsed candidate  
14     pursuant to section 9-388 or as receiving at least fifteen per cent of the  
15     convention vote for such office pursuant to this subsection."
