**"AN ACT CONCERNING PROPERTY TAX COLLECTION."**

1 Strike out lines 1 to 5, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the  
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. Section 12-144 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 Any property tax due in any municipality of this state in an amount  
6 not in excess of [one hundred] two hundred fifty dollars shall be due  
7 and payable in a single payment when so determined by the  
8 appropriating body of such municipality.

9 Sec. 2. Section 12-144c of the general statutes is repealed and the  
10 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

11 Any municipality may [by action of its legislative body,] waive any  
12 property tax due in an amount less than [five] twenty-five dollars by  
13 action of its legislative body before the date such tax is due.

14       Sec. 3. This act shall take effect October 1, 2001, and shall be  
15       applicable to assessment years commencing on and after said date."
