"AN ACT CONCERNING VIDEO GAMES."

1 Strike out everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(NEW) (a) No owner of a business for profit where video games,
4 including a violent point and shoot video simulator, are provided for
5 entertainment shall permit a person under the age of eighteen to
6 operate a violent point and shoot video simulator. A violent point and
7 shoot video simulator is a device that involves a game in which one or
8 more individuals fire simulated firearms at a video screen which
9 displays, as a target, any type of representation of a human being
10 including, but not limited to, video, photographic or animated, or
11 silhouette of a human being.

12 (b) Any such owner as provided in subsection (a) of this section
13 who permits a person under the age of eighteen to operate a violent
14 point and shoot video simulator in violation of this section shall be
15 assessed a civil penalty of not more than one thousand dollars for each

16 violation by the Commissioner of Consumer Protection. The Attorney
17 General, upon complaint of the Commissioner of Consumer
18 Protection, shall institute a civil action to recover such penalty."
