**"AN ACT CONCERNING A UNIFORM ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEW
PROCESS RELATED TO CERTAIN STATE-REIMBURSED
PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS, PROPERTY TAX CREDITS AND
RENTAL REBATES."**

1 After line 756, add the following and renumber the remaining
2 sections accordingly:

3 "Sec. 12. Section 12-81w of the general statutes is repealed and the
4 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 The legislative body of any municipality may establish, by
6 ordinance, a program to provide property tax relief for the nonsalaried
7 local director of civil preparedness and for individuals who volunteer
8 their services as a firefighter, emergency medical technician,
9 paramedic, civil preparedness staff or ambulance driver in the
10 municipality. Such tax relief may provide either (1) an abatement of up
11 to one thousand dollars in property taxes due for any fiscal year, or (2)
12 an exemption applicable to the assessed value of real or personal
13 property up to an amount equal to the quotient of one million dollars

14 divided by the mill rate, in effect at the time of assessment, expressed
15 as a whole number of dollars per one thousand dollars of assessed
16 value. Any ordinance may authorize interlocal agreements for the
17 purpose of providing property tax relief to such volunteers who live in
18 one municipality but volunteer their services in another municipality."
