 - 10 out-of-state placements."

 - 12 "Sec. 2. Not later than January 1, 2002, the Department of Children

13 and Families, the Department of Public Health, the Department of
14 Education, and the Office of the Child Advocate, shall submit a report
15 to the General Assembly, in accordance with section 11-4a of the
16 general statutes, on its findings and recommendations concerning the
17 creation of an independent licensing and monitoring authority for
18 residential facilities for children."
