**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE CONVEYANCE OF CERTAIN PARCELS OF STATE LAND."**

1 Strike lines 365 to 367, inclusive, and insert the following in lieu  
2 thereof:

3 "(b) (1) The town of Farmington may either retain the parcel of land  
4 described in subsection (a) of this section or exchange said parcel of  
5 land with the owner of another parcel of land.

6 (2) If the town of Farmington retains the parcel of land described in  
7 subsection (a) of this section, the town shall use said parcel for  
8 recreational or open space purposes. If the town does not use the  
9 parcel for recreational or open space purposes or sells or leases all or  
10 any portion of the parcel, the parcel shall revert to the state of  
11 Connecticut.

12 (3) If the town of Farmington exchanges the parcel of land described  
13 in subsection (a) of this section with the owner of another parcel of  
14 land, the town shall use the parcel that it receives in the exchange for

15 recreational or open space purposes. If the town does not use the  
16 parcel that it receives in said exchange for said purposes, the parcel  
17 described in subsection (a) of this section shall revert to the state."
