1 In line 1, before "Subsection", insert "Section 1."

2 After line 55, insert the following:

3 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 14-222 of the general statutes is
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

5 (a) (1) No person shall operate any motor vehicle upon any public
6 highway of the state, or any road of any specially chartered municipal
7 association or of any district organized under the provisions of chapter
8 105, a purpose of which is the construction and maintenance of roads
9 and sidewalks, or in any parking area for ten cars or more or upon any
10 private road on which a speed limit has been established in accordance
11 with the provisions of section 14-218a or upon any school property
12 recklessly, having regard to the width, traffic and use of such highway,
13 road, school property or parking area, the intersection of streets and

14 the weather conditions.

15 (2) The operation of a motor vehicle upon any such highway, road
16 or parking area for ten cars or more at such a rate of speed as to
17 endanger the life of any person other than the operator of such motor
18 vehicle, or the operation, downgrade, upon any highway, of any motor
19 vehicle with a commercial registration with the clutch or gears
20 disengaged, or the operation knowingly of a motor vehicle with
21 defective mechanism, shall constitute a violation of the provisions of
22 this section.

23 (3) The operation of a motor vehicle upon any such highway, road
24 or parking area for ten cars or more at a rate of speed greater than
25 [eighty-five] twenty miles per hour above the posted speed limit shall
26 constitute a violation of the provisions of this section."
