**"AN ACT CONCERNING ENHANCEMENTS TO THE CHILD
SUPPORT ENFORCEMENT SYSTEM."**

1 Strike lines 254 to 263, inclusive, in their entirety and insert the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) No consumer collection agency shall impose a charge or fee for
4 any child support payments collected through the efforts of a
5 governmental agency. No consumer collection agency shall impose a
6 charge or fee for the collection of any child support payments in excess
7 of twenty per cent of any payment received by the creditor to whom
8 child support is owed for a period of six months from the date of
9 receipt of the first payment, provided the six-month period may be
10 reestablished if there are no payments for a period of not less than two
11 months and payments are subsequently received because of further
12 efforts of the consumer collection agency. No fee may be charged

13 except in accordance with the provisions of this subsection."
