**"AN ACT CONCERNING REGIONAL WATER POLLUTION
CONTROL AUTHORITY JURISDICTION."**

1 Strike out everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (a) As used in this section, "resident municipality" means
4 a municipality in which Bolton Lakes are situated in whole or in part
5 and "adjacent municipality" means a municipality that borders on a
6 resident municipality.

7 (b) Notwithstanding section 22a-518 of the general statutes, a
8 resident municipality may form a regional water pollution control
9 authority with another resident municipality or an adjacent
10 municipality, or both, the jurisdiction of which shall be limited to the
11 constituent municipalities but need not be congruent with their
12 outermost boundaries. Such authority shall have the same powers as a
13 regional water pollution control authority created pursuant to section
14 22a-500 of the general statutes and shall comply with any federal, state

15 or local environmental laws or regulations.

16 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2001."
