"AN ACT CONCERNING MASTERY TEST EXEMPTIONS."

1 After line 15, insert the following:

2 "Sec. 2. Section 29-3a of the general statutes is repealed and the
3 following is substituted in lieu thereof:

4 [After graduation from the State Police Training Academy, and

5 before] Not later than five years after becoming a sworn member of the
6 Division of State Police within the Department of Public Safety, all
7 state police trainees shall have [received a high school diploma or an
8 equivalent approved by the state Department of Education] obtained
9 not less than an associate degree from an institution of higher
10 education accredited by the Board of Governors of Higher Education.
11 Nothing in this section shall prohibit prospective state police
12 applicants from being admitted to the State Police Training Academy
13 and being sworn in without having [received either the high school
14 diploma or equivalent] obtained such higher education."

15 In line 16, strike "Sec. 2." and insert in lieu thereof "Sec. 3."

16 In line 16, before the period, insert ", except that section 2 shall take
17 effect October 1, 2001"
