**"AN ACT CONCERNING FEES FOR NONCOMMERCIAL MOTOR
VEHICLES OWNED BY CERTAIN VETERANS."**

1 In line 1, before "Subsection" insert "Section 1."

2 After line 23, insert the following:

3 "Sec. 2. Subsection (a) of section 10-29a of the general statutes is
4 amended by adding subdivisions (47), (48) and (49) as follows:

5 (NEW) (47) The Governor shall proclaim August sixteenth of each
6 year to be Airborne Day. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State
7 Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance
8 of the day.

9 (NEW) (48) The Governor shall proclaim the third Friday in
10 September of each year to be Prisoner of War and Missing in Action
11 Recognition Day. Suitable exercises shall be held in the State Capitol
12 and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the observance of the

13 day.

14 (NEW) (49) The Governor shall proclaim April ninth of each year to
15 be Former Prisoner of War Day. Suitable exercises shall be held in the
16 State Capitol and elsewhere as the Governor designates for the
17 observance of the day."
