3 "(b) On or before September 1, 2002, each local and regional board of
4 education shall specify the basic skills necessary for graduation for
5 classes graduating in 2006, and for each graduating class thereafter,
6 and include a process to assess a student's level of competency in such
7 skills through use of the tenth grade mastery examination under
8 section 10-14n and other assessment methods. Each local and regional
9 board of education shall identify a course of study for those students
10 who have not successfully completed the assessment criteria to assist
11 such students to reach a satisfactory level of competency prior to
12 graduation."
