"AN ACT CONCERNING WEIGH STATIONS."

1 Strike section 2 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 2. (NEW) The Commissioners of Public Safety and Motor
4 Vehicles shall suspend operation of truck safety inspection stations in
5 Middletown and, at such time as a new truck safety station is
6 established at a location between Waterford and the Rhode Island
7 border, in Waterford."
