**"AN ACT CONCERNING MAIL-IN VOTER REGISTRATION PROCEDURES."**

1 Strike out subdivision (5) of subsection (f) of section 23 in its entirety  
2 and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(5) No individual who is an owner of a firm which provides  
4 investment services and to which the Treasurer pays compensation,  
5 expenses or fees or issues a contract, and no individual who is  
6 employed by such a firm as a manager, officer, director, partner or  
7 employee with managerial or discretionary responsibilities to invest,  
8 manage funds or provide investment services for brokerage,  
9 underwriting and financial advisory activities which are in the  
10 statutory and constitutional purview of the Treasurer, may make a  
11 contribution to, or solicit contributions on behalf of, an exploratory  
12 committee or candidate committee established by a candidate for  
13 nomination or election to [any public office] the office of Governor,

14 Lieutenant Governor, Secretary of the State, Comptroller, Attorney  
15 General, state senator or state representative. The provisions of this  
16 subdivision shall not restrict any such individual who is a candidate  
17 for any such office from establishing a candidate committee and  
18 soliciting contributions for such individual's own campaign."
