"AN ACT CONCERNING STATE EMPLOYEES CALLED TO ACTIVE DUTY IN THE ARMED FORCES OF A STATE OR THE UNITED STATES IN SUPPORT OF OPERATION ENDURING FREEDOM OR OPERATION NOBLE EAGLE."

1 After subsection (c), insert the following:

2 "(d) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, any
3 person who is a member of the armed forces of the state or of any
4 reserve component of the armed forces of the United States and who
5 has been called to active service in the armed forces of the state or the
6 United States for service during the period commencing on September
7 11, 2001, and lasting for the duration of Operation Enduring Freedom
8 or Operation Noble Eagle until the cessation of hostilities as
9 determined by the President of the United States or until a date
10 established by an act of the General Assembly, and who is assigned to
11 a post located more than forty miles from his place of primary
12 residence, shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for travel and
13 lodging, necessarily incurred in connection with such assignment if
14 such reimbursement is not provided pursuant to federal law or

15 regulation."
