AN ACT CONCERNING MEDICAL SAVINGS ACCOUNTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 38a-493 and 38a-520 of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to exempt qualified high deductible health insurance plans
- 3 from certain deductible requirements to permit the sale of federally
- 4 qualified medical savings accounts in this state.

Statement of Purpose:

To exempt federally qualified "medical savings accounts" from state deductible requirements.
