AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYMENT PROTECTION FOR CRIME VICTIMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit an employer from
- 2 terminating an employee solely on the basis of the employee's status as
- 3 a crime victim.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect employees who have been crime victims from unfair treatment in the workplace.
