AN ACT CONCERNING THE OFFICE OF POLICY AND MANAGEMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) The Secretary of the Office of Policy
- 2 and Management shall conduct a study of the operations of the Office
- 3 of Policy and Management and submit a report on the secretary's
- 4 findings and recommendations not later than January 1, 2003, to the
- 5 joint standing committee of the General Assembly having cognizance
- 6 of matters relating to government administration.

This act shall take effect as follows:
