House Bill No. 5677

*House of Representatives, April 8, 2002*

The Committee on Judiciary reported through REP. LAWLOR of the 99th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the House, that the bill ought to pass.

## **AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMPOSITION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 18-78 of the general statutes, as amended by  
2 section 2 of public act 01-20, is repealed and the following is  
3 substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2002*):

4 There is established a state Department of Correction, which shall  
5 consist of the Enfield Correctional Institution, Enfield; the Northern  
6 Correctional Institution, Somers; the Osborn Correctional Institution,  
7 Somers; the Carl Robinson Correctional Institution, Enfield; the  
8 William Willard-Alexander J. Cybulski Correctional Institution,  
9 Enfield; the Bridgeport Correctional Center, Bridgeport; the Cheshire  
10 Correctional Institution, Cheshire; the Ward A. Garner Correctional  
11 Institution, Newtown; the John R. Manson Youth Institution, Cheshire;  
12 the New Haven Correctional Center, New Haven; the Noah Daniel  
13 Webster Correctional Institution, Cheshire; the Brooklyn Correctional

14 Institution, Brooklyn; the Raymond L. Corrigan-Stanley J. Radgowski  
15 Correctional Institution, Uncasville; the Bernard J. Gates Correctional  
16 Institution, Niantic; the Donald T. Bergin Correctional Institution,  
17 Mansfield; [the Stanley J. Radgowski Correctional Institution,  
18 Uncasville;] the Janet S. York Correctional Institution, Niantic; the  
19 Hartford Correctional Center, Hartford; the Ellis R. MacDougall-Ralph  
20 H. Walker Correctional Institution, Suffield; [the Ralph H. Walker  
21 Reception and Special Management Unit, Suffield;] and community  
22 enforcement offices located in Bridgeport, Hartford, New Haven,  
23 Norwich and Waterbury.

This act shall take effect as follows:

**AN ACT CONCERNING THE COMPOSITION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CORRECTION**

**SUMMARY:**

This bill eliminates the unit called the Ralph H. Walker Reception and Special Management Unit, Suffield, to reflect the Department of Correction's current operational structure.

The bill renames (1) the Raymond L. Corrigan-Correctional Institution in Uncasville as the Raymond L. Corrigan-Stanley J. Radgowski Correctional Institution, and (2) the Ellis R. MacDougall Correctional Institution in Suffield, the Ellis R. MacDougall-Ralph H. Walker Correctional Institution.
