**Explanation**

The bill extends the time for the Claims Commissioner to dispose of certain claims against the state in accordance with PA 01-167, "An Act Concerning Decisions of the Claims Commissioner," which established time limits for the disposition of claims and provided that the General Assembly may authorize extensions of time to dispose of claims. The fiscal impact is indeterminate because the merits of the claims (and the subsequent likelihood of awards) cannot be judged in advance.
