Substitute Senate Bill No. 308

Senate, March 15, 2002

The Committee on Energy and Technology reported through SEN. PETERS of the 20th Dist., Chairperson of the Committee on the part of the Senate, that the substitute bill ought to pass.

AN ACT CONCERNING A STATE-WIDE 311 NUMBER.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The Department of Public Utility
2 Control shall, within available appropriations, in conjunction with the
3 Department of Public Safety and Infoline of Connecticut, develop a
4 plan for the implementation of a state-wide nonemergency
5 governmental telecommunications service to be known as 311 service.
6 Not later than January 1, 2003, the Department of Public Utility
7 Control shall submit such plan to the joint standing committee of the
8 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to energy and
9 technology in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
10 general statutes.

This act shall take effect as follows:

Section 1	<i>July 1, 2002</i>
