AN ACT CONCERNING THE LAKE GARDA IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 3 of number 255 of the special acts of 1943 is
2 amended to read as follows (*Effective from passage*):

3 The objects of [said association] The Lake Garda Improvement
4 Association shall be to provide for the improvement of the lands in
5 said territory and for the health, comfort, protection and convenience
6 of the inhabitants thereof.

This act shall take effect as follows:
