AN ACT CONCERNING ASSISTED LIVING SERVICES IN MANAGED RESIDENTIAL COMMUNITIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2002*) The sum of ___ dollars is
2 appropriated to the Department of Public Health, from the General
3 Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2003, for the purpose of
4 reimbursing managed residential communities, as described in
5 subsection (e) of section 8-206e of the general statutes, as amended, for
6 the provision of assisted living services to residents of managed
7 residential communities who meet the eligibility requirements for Title
8 XIX, or state medical assistance.

This act shall take effect as follows:	
Section 1	<i>July 1, 2002</i>

To allow elderly citizens greater self-sufficiency and continuity of care at decreased costs to the state.
