AN ACT CONCERNING ADULT EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 10-71 of the general statutes is
2 amended by adding subdivision (4) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2002*):

3 (NEW) (4) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivisions (1) to (3),
4 inclusive, of this subsection, on and after July 1, 2002, each local or
5 regional board of education or regional educational service center shall
6 receive full reimbursement for all eligible costs for adult education.

7 Sec. 2. Section 10-285a of the general statutes is amended by adding
8 subsection (i) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2002*):

9 (NEW) (i) If a school building project for a new building or for the
10 expansion, extension, alteration or renovation of an existing building
11 includes space for an adult education program, the percentage
12 determined pursuant to this section shall be increased by ten
13 percentage points, but shall not exceed one hundred per cent, for the
14 portion of the building used primarily for such purpose.

This act shall take effect as follows:

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for full reimbursement to local and regional boards of education and regional educational service centers for eligible costs for adult education, and to provide for a ten per cent increase in the percentage of school building project grant money when the building project includes space for an adult education program.
